





#### **Restoration Project**

John Pellicano has been busy recently by undertaking a challenging restoration of a small RC Yacht for a local youth. The yacht in question is one of FAI's small Oceanis 600's. These unique hand built but still mass produced yachts come from Vietnam and have a balsa planked hull that has been sealed on the inside with resin and sheathed on the outside with fiberglass prior to painting. The boat itself was in a bad



way when John brought it down to the Bunker for an initial look. The RC gear in the boat was corroded badly and could not be saved so was removed. There was deck cracks that needed repair as well as one of the internal frames. The rig also needed a tidy up to remove all traces of corrosion. Hopefully John will have this project finished soon and we can see some pic's of the boat back in action.

### **Project X**

Amongst IOM refurbishments and completion of another new IOM, Project X (see drawing and photos at right) has reared it's head again this winter with skippers showing interest in a rugged and reliable boat that can built by the average skipper using only products from the hobby shop and the hardware etc...Preliminary drawings and a basic hull are now complete and phase two has started in the form of weight and balance adjustments prior to completing the plan.


The boat has been designed so that it and all it's rigs, RC equipment and simple tools can all fit in a box not much bigger than the boat itself and be placed on the backseat of the car or carried on public transport without the need for the large and cumbersome rig bags associated with IOMs and alike.

The hull is one metre in length and is of a hardchine style made from thin ply to simplify building. It is envisaged that the boats displacement will be somewhere in the vicinity of 3.5kg's and will utilise the same sail style and area as the Soling One Metre.

A simple Hitec drum winch will be suitable for the boat but some may wish to use an arm winch instead.

More news to follow as the next prototype hull and rig nears completion sometime nearer to the end of this year.



### The Star 45

This months special feature focuses on an old favourite of mine called the Star 45. I think what attracts me to it is that it is large, simple to build, of a hardchine nature yet looks like a real yacht. The Star 45 is a 45 inch hard chine hull designed as a semi scale model of the full size Olympic Star Class Yacht.

The original International Star Class Olympic Yacht is an American design that dates back to 1910 when it was first designed as a one design racing yacht for skippers who were not terribly wealthy. It started life with a large gaff rig which had some three feet of it's mainsail hanging out past the end of the transom but after experimenting with rigs the boat ended up with the traditional rig in the 1920's that it still uses today.

The Star 45 is sailed in various clubs throughout the American Model Yachting Association and can either be built using the plans specified in the rules or can be purchased as a kit from one of a number of AMYA approved manufacturers.



One noticeable change in the Star 45 compared to the full size Star is the model version uses a longer high aspect ration fin and bulb assembly to assist in balancing the huge rig along with a spade type rudder (see photo on next page.









### Vintage Model Yachts
