

SMYS Starts Sailing

After months of preparation and test sailing the Sydney Model Yacht Squadron (SMYS) held its first meeting at it's new venue on the Parramatta River at Putney during August. The inaugural sail was attended by six of the eight new members and although there were not enough boats for each skipper to sail everybody had a sail of the three IOM's in attendance.

Some old favorites such as John Bartram's "Sarge" and Graham McKay's round bilge "Rhythm" were brought out of retirement and were on hand as club boats to ensure that each of the new skippers got to try out an RC IOM. These boats, now some 10 and 15 years old respectively put in a good show against newer designs.

The venue has proven to be a good spot to sail despite the need for a wet launch. Several skippers have purchased thigh height fishing waders to assist with the launching and retrieval process. With very


The SMYS has taken delivery of its first major acquisition

Maximuss Update

Project Maximuss has regained some headway over the past few months with the Prototype boat owned by John Bartram going through several modifications. The largest of those modifications being the addition of an extra long bulb with a nose up angle of 3 degrees. The boat has been behaving perfectly no more rounding up and the mast no longer needs to be raked aft to get the boat to sail properly. Recent outings on the Parramatta River has seen the boat sailed in both light and heavy conditions utilizing all three rigs.

Saturday the 6th of October saw *Maximuss* in company with my Robbe Windstar (*Sarge*) sailing in wind speeds of 44km/h gusting to 67 km/h using their B-Rigs. They were a bit overpowered in the gusts but otherwise were controllable. The boats could have kept sailing in the higher wind speeds but the C-Rigs were left at home that day, *oh well!*

More Maximuss news in the form of Graham McKay's boat nearing completion. The boat is currently in my workshop getting its bright yellow and clear gloss top coat applied.

Maximuss Mk2

With such a good result with the Maximuss Mk1 as my first design plans are afoot to start designing the Maximuss Mk2. This time the hull

design will be prepared using naval architect/ yacht design computer software to ensure the hydrostatics and fin/rig placement are carried out correctly. More news as it comes to hand.

"The Thing"

With the need for new IOM's to suit the conditions of Kissing Point Bay being paramount all options are being explored including a hull that was given to me by a leading RC Yacht builder. The hull is a complete hull and deck in one piece originally carved out of a foam, covered in brown post office tape and then fibreglassed. The foam is latter removed by dissolving it with acetone. More news on this project as it progresses.


The RG65 RC Yacht.

Late last year and earlier this year there has been talk amongst some skippers of sailing Pocket Rocket type RC Yachts in the 650mm—750mmrange. While reading Marine Modelling International and surfing the RC Yacht links on the web I have come across the following class of RC Yacht that some of you might find interesting to play around with.

The "RG-65" is a Radio Controlled monohull development class, where all is allowed except what is specifically prohibited by a set of rules of measurement. The rules basically state that the boat can be no longer than 650mm, rig no higher than 110mm and sail area is limited to 2252 cm2. The rules are similar to those for the IOM governing dimensions of hull, fin and rig but allowing scope for hull design, fin and bulb shape etc...

The class seems to be growing rapidly in IOM clubs and dedicated RG65 clubs throughout South America and Europe with an International Association and several National Association supporting the various clubs.






